The puppy is sold to the purchaser on the following conditions:

The breeder has followed the Labrador Breed Standard and used the East Africa Kennel Club (EAKC) health schemes and certification to ensure that the sire and dam are sound breeding stock. The puppies have been reared in a home environment and have been wormed at two weeks, four weeks and six weeks. The puppy is believed to be in good health.

The purchaser is strongly advised to have the puppy vet checked within three days of collecting the puppy. If the vet certifies that there is any problem which makes the puppy unfit for sale such as it is suffering from any hereditary disease, provided the puppy is returned in the same condition as when it was sold, and within seven days, the breeder will take the puppy back and refund the full purchase price. **Please note** that parasites are not included and are sometimes common and easily treated. The purchaser must recognize that intestinal parasites are not uncommon in puppies and very often develop during the puppy's early development. The purchaser must also realize that the stress of going to a new home environment and travel can actually result in the appearance of intestinal parasites. The breeder will not pay expenses incurred in the return of a puppy nor accept any claim for distress caused by the return.

The breeder has enquired of the purchaser his or her past experience with dogs and in particular with Labrador Retrievers and on the basis of the information received is willing to place

a puppy with the purchaser. The breeder has pointed out to the purchaser the main conditions the breed is prone to and the health schemes followed to reduce the risk of such conditions. Every puppy is an individual and the breeder cannot be held responsible should conditions, genetic or otherwise, develop later in life.

The puppy will be sold on a **limited EAKC registration**, which will be lifted by the Breeder after 18 months, when the results of the hip scores have been submitted to the Breeder. Such certification will be obtained at the expense of the Buyer at 18 months of age.

The purchaser agrees that the dog will be kept in appropriate conditions for its welfare and health. It will be fed on a suitable diet for its age and condition and have appropriate exercise. It will receive all necessary veterinary care to maintain its physical good health. The dog will be kept under appropriate control and will not be neglected or maltreated in any way.

If circumstances occur where it becomes necessary to re-home the dog, the breeder must first be notified and given an opportunity to take back the dog either by purchase (in the case of selling on) or to home it if it is in need of rehoming.
